Grapevine Shuttle has provided shuttle service that guests can take from our hotel to various Grapevine areas of attraction. This service is meant for individuals or small groups. If you have a large group, you will need to arrange for separate transportation. There is a flat daily fee of \$5 per person (Exact CASH fare is required). - Passengers must be at the stop about 5 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.
- To maintain an on-time schedule, drivers are unable to wait for passengers.
- Smoking, eating and drinking are not permitted on the shuttle.
- A driver may refuse to transport a passenger under the influence of alcohol, illegal or dangerous substances or whose behavior or language appears abusive, offensive, disorderly or dangerous to the driver or other passengers.
- Service dogs are permitted on the shuttle, but "pets" are not.
- Shuttle capacity is 23 passengers or less when accommodating wheelchairs.
- Shuttles are accessible for common wheelchairs that are equipped with tie-down strap attachments. Each shuttle can accommodate up to two wheelchairs. Shuttle seating capacity is reduced when wheelchairs are being accommodated.
- Visitors who depart their hotels during the last hour of operation are responsible to find their own return transportation.
- Due to its small size, the Grapevine Visitors Shuttle is not able to provide transfers for groups. Groups need to contract with a private charter service.

Grapevine Shuttle is a private entity and is not partnered with Westin, Shalman Temple No. 90 or Daughters of the Nile.

Located on the campus of Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas, the George W. Bush Presidential Library and Museum serves as a resource for the study of the life and career of George W. Bush, while also promoting a better understanding of the Presidency, American history, and important issues of public policy. Housed inside the Bush Center, the Library features a 20-foot-tall, 360-degree high-definition video wall; a full-size replica of White House Oval Office; and the original White House Situation Room, now the setting for a unique, interactive educational experience for students. Among the 43,000 artifacts held at the Library, the "Nation Under Attack" exhibit displays steel from the World Trade Center that visitors may touch, the bullhorn President Bush used to address the crowd at Ground Zero, and letters he received in the days following the attacks.
